Article 1: Name of ASB Activity

Article 6: Elections

- **Section A:** To call for an Election of a Secretary or ASB Student Representative 80% of members must be present and voting. To start an election there must be a 50+% majority vote. In order to win a person must have a 2/3 majority vote.
- If there are no volunteers to take a post then each member writes the name of another member's name on a sheet of paper. Whichever member has the most votes in appointed the position. In this case on minimum percentage is necessary.

Article 7: Amendments

An ASB Activity must have a 2/3 majority vote in order to amend its constitution. All amendments must be cleared through Ms. Ward.

Article 8: Quorum/Decisions

In order to make decisions pertaining to the current meeting (like what should be done today) we must have 1% members present and voting.

In order to make decisions that have effect on future meetings we must have 80% of the members present and voting
