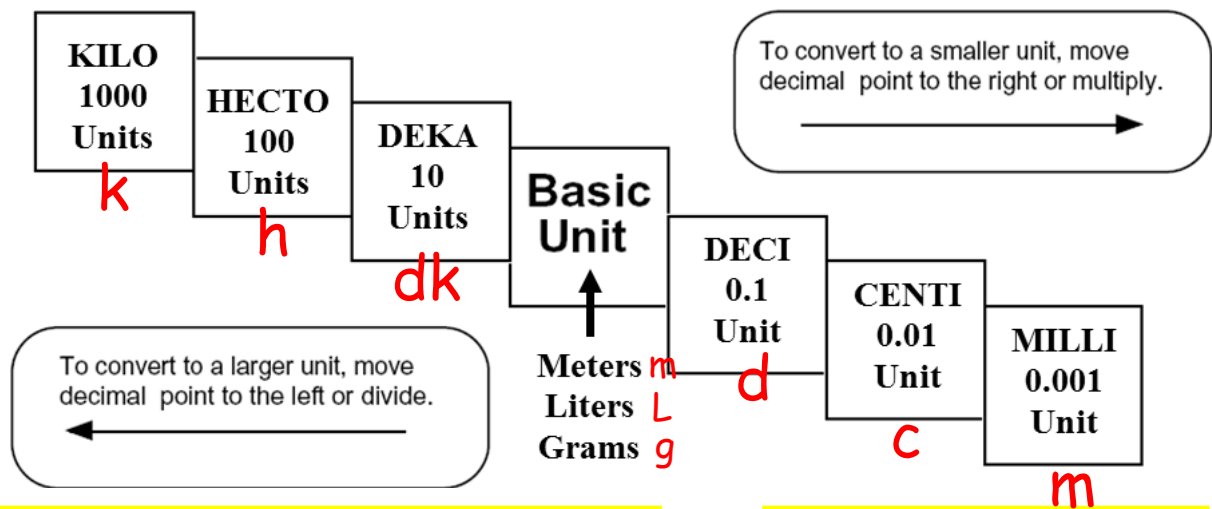


# Ladder Method



## How do you use the “ladder” method?

- 1<sup>st</sup> – Determine your starting point.
- 2<sup>nd</sup> – Count the “jumps” to your ending point.
- 3<sup>rd</sup> – Move the decimal the same number of jumps in the same direction.

$$4 \text{ km} = \underline{\hspace{2cm}} \text{ m}$$

↑
↑  
 Starting Point      Ending Point

How many jumps does it take?

$$4.\underbrace{\quad}_{1}.\underbrace{\quad}_{2}.\underbrace{\quad}_{3}. = 4000 \text{ m}$$
