

Public v. Private

Public Colleges/Universities typically require:

- □ Application may include Essay + Fee
- □ Test scores sent directly from testing agency
- Transcript sent via Parchment

Private Colleges/Universities typically require:

- □ Application will most likely include multiple writing prompts + Fee
- □ Test scores sent directly from testing agency
- Transcript sent via Parchment
- □ Recommendations (usually at least one teacher and one counselor rec.)

- If more than one is required ask teachers from different disciplines


How to ask....
