World Language	Must <b>NOT</b> be a repeat of same level language taken at BHS. First year of language at BHS is equivalent to 121 at the college level; second year is equivalent to 122 at the college level, and third year is equivalent to 123 at the college level.	
Math	Algebra 2 at BHS is equivalent to MTH 098 at SCC and MTH 099 at OC **Running Start does not pay for courses below the 100 level. Pre-calculus is equivalent to Math 141 and 142 at SCC and OC.	
Career Education	The following courses may satisfy BHS requirements: Business, Family & Consumer Science, Technology Education, Computer Science and Work Experience. Contact Mr. Ward for approval.	
Physical Education (PE)	A PE course taken at either college will fulfill a PE credit at BHS as long as it is two credits or more.	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Running Start Students are strongly encouraged to take their required courses as soon as possible. If students wait until the spring of their senior year they may discover that a required course is not offered or gets canceled which will jeopardize graduation.</li> <li>• Running Start students must meet BHS high school graduation requirements including the BHS school policy that requires students seeking a PE waiver to maintain a full schedule during every semester/quarter that they are enrolled. A full-time Running Start student must carry at least 12 credits per community college quarter.</li> <li>• Students may not select courses that they think might fulfill the requirements listed above. Students must schedule an appointment with Mr. Ward well in advance of registering for each quarter to be sure all Bainbridge High School graduation requirements are being met.</li> </ul>
