Staff and outside presenters lead BISD Tech PD classes.</p> <p>-BISD Tech PD is offered each school year</p> <p>-Teachers have participated in conferences such as Google Summit, National Council of Computing in Education (NCCE), and Washington Education Research Council (WERA)</p> <p>-Staff participate on technology committees and special focus work teams, such as site visits to other school districts to learn from colleagues</p>
