- Eagle Harbor is a small community
 - **Build relationships with your teachers**
 - The teacher is a collaborator in education
 - Call your teachers by their first name
 - Student self-advocacy encouraged
 - **You are seen (SEL support)**
 - Your teachers know who you are as a person, and not just as a student in the gradebook
 - **In support of the “whole student”**
 - Snack Station, Flex Room, Flexible classroom seating etc.
 - Interdisciplinary and cross curricular connections help students see the “big picture” of learning in a way that is authentic to the real world.

Structure

- Eagle Harbor is a team
 - Students attend classes in mixed grade levels with the same teachers over a few years.
 - Clubs and activities are built **by the students** around what the students want to participate in.
 - All assemblies are planned and executed by the **student leadership team.**
 - Activities, parties, game nights, and other events planned by the student leadership team.
 - Monthly Advisories where **staff dialogue with students and implement changes** and growth in our program from student ideas.

Methodology

- Eagle Harbor is a place of innovative teaching and learning. We embrace options!
- **Seminar style courses** engage students in collaborative and discussion based work
- Classes offer a “low floor/high ceiling” approach- allowing students who are ready for a challenge to seek that extra step and students who need additional time or support to get their needs met as well.

- Courses designed with students in mind.
 - We are responsive to student interest and need.
 - Projects and assignments often have a degree of choice in how students complete them.
- Built in scaffolds and supports so students can learn and grow at a pace that fits their needs
- Homework club for tutoring or extra time and Achieve class for credit
- Interdisciplinary work allows students to see work from multiple lenses and apply it to the real world.

Independent Study / Contracts / PBL

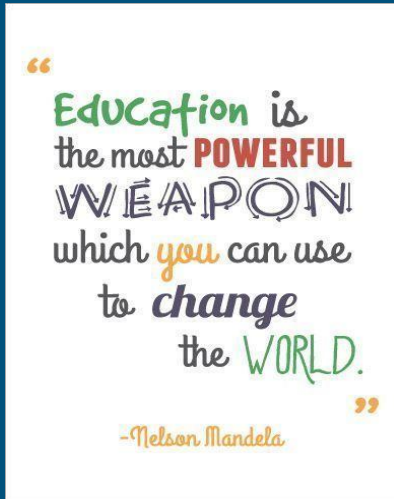
Explore your passions



EHHS students have the opportunity to pursue a passion or interest and earn credit through independent studies or Project Based Learning (PBL).

- Students work with a teacher as their academic advisor to develop a “syllabus” and learning goals.
- Students meet weekly on progress and share monthly projects with peers and advisors.
- Successful independent studies have mentors, are passion based with structure.
- .5 high school credit = 90 hours or 5 hours/week of experiential learning
- Examples: Dance/Ballet, Club Sports, Instrumental Music, Latin, Fine Arts, Career Exploration, and Travel Study.

Why Choose EHHS?

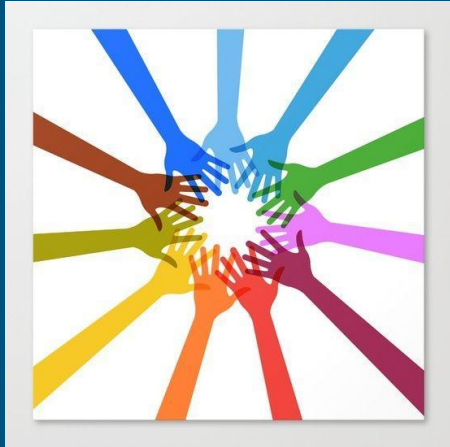


- Students can access BHS electives and other advanced courses as needed.
