Overview to today's meeting agenda provided by Jeff.

Update on kindergarten referral -- Jeff (10)

Students were referred and given the CogAT screener. Parent rating form was included with nomination permission. MDT reviewed information along with teacher HOPE scale and report card grades from the semester. Letters to parents are going out tomorrow. Judy shared that the prior letters for not qualifying were considered a bit harsh and suggested softening the language which Jeff said he could do before they go out tomorrow. Although appeal process is outlined, Judy shared it's hard for parents to know what to bring forth for an appeal. Discussion of how best to communicate a message to parents.

Recommendations for process for identifying HC area for young students

(math/ ELA) -- All (20)

Jeff shared some history of identifying the young students as "highly capable" but not domain specific until a little older. Last month's meeting, feedback was provided on what grade is appropriate for identification of domain. K, 1, and 2 students are not qualified by domain at this time. Agreement we don't want to retest students in order to identify by domain at a higher grade level. Today's small group task was to decide what grade is appropriate for the identification of domain. Group discussion of why and how designation is used. Triad groups of mixed staff/parent to discuss and provide input on the appropriate grade level for domain identification. Group agreement to identify at the end of 4th grade prior to moving to 5th grade based on current data and teacher input. Process to be developed prior to the end of this year.
