



Highly Capable Program Referral Information

Bainbridge Island School District offers services to students who have been identified as highly capable. Highly capable students are those who perform or show potential for performing at significantly advanced academic levels. Services are provided for students in grades K - 12.

Students who are referred will have a cognitive assessment administered by trained BISD staff. A BISD team will review the student's cumulative file, recent testing results and other standardized academic assessments. Parents/guardians will be notified of the results of the testing and team decision regarding placement and services. Nominations may be made by the student's parents, teachers, staff or community members. Nominations are accepted for students in grades K - 12 who are not currently in the BISD highly capable program and have not taken the cognitive assessment used by BISD in the current school year.
