3. Budget substantial amount.

Implementation Review (IR)

1. Implement adopted curriculum.
2. Focus on instruction and inservice.
3. Evaluate implementation.
4. Determine modification needs.
5. Budget substantial amount

Mid-cycle Review (MR)

1. Review existing program implementation.
2. Determine needs for supplemental material, inservice, and program modification.
3. Budget for program modification.
