

### **NONRESIDENT STUDENTS**

Any student residing outside the boundaries of Bainbridge Island School District wishing to attend a school within the district may apply for admission by completing the following application process:

1. The appropriate application form (Exhibit 3140/3141) shall be completed by the parent/guardian on behalf of his/her student, or by a student at least eighteen (18) years old.
2. The student must have the release of the school district in which he/she resides.
3. At the request of school administration, the student, accompanied by his/her parent or guardian, shall complete an in-person interview with the principal or associate principal of the school the student wishes to attend.
4. Within each grading period (quarter, trimester, semester) the student must maintain the following in order to sustain enrollment in Bainbridge Island School District:
  - a. Satisfactory academic progress.
  - b. A disciplinary record with no incidences of violent, destructive or disruptive behavior, or gang membership.
  - c. A disciplinary record with no truancy, suspensions, expulsions, or poor attendance.
  - d. No significant changes in the circumstances under which the acceptance was granted.
  - e. Fulfillment of all agreements for any contract made for admittance and continued enrollment.
